While the needs of students grow, our ability to fund awards has decreased dramatically, from 51 scholarships in 1985, to 13 in 2025.

The national average for Canadian tuition has skyrocketed by nearly 800% since 1982.<sup>2</sup> We have not been able to increase scholarship values since 2005.

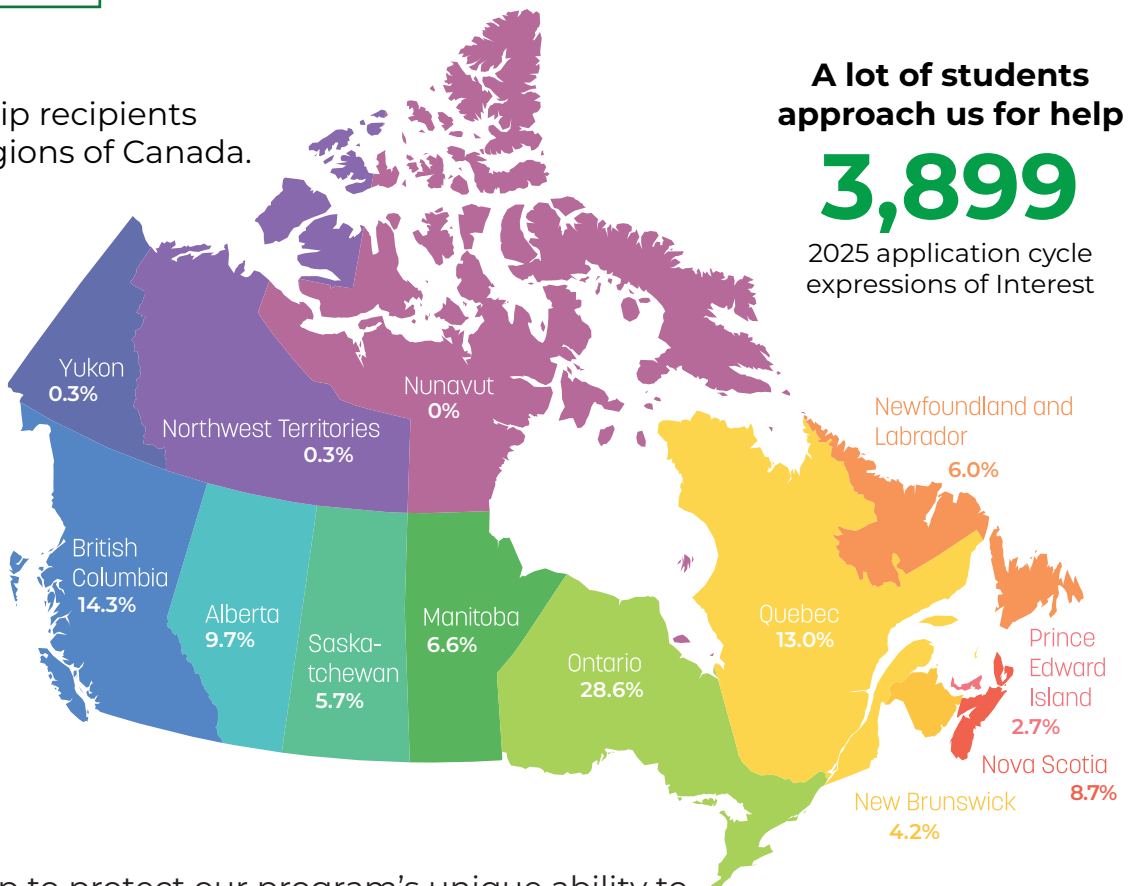


Female Recipients
